COMMUNICATION

We love engaging with our parent community and keeping the lines of communication open in order to best support your children and their learning. In order to achieve this more efficiently, this term we have been working with a team of experts on streamlining our processes of communication within the school. Here are some highlights of the guidelines:-

- Please use Seesaw to communicate with your class teacher about your child's learning and events at school.
- If you would like to arrange a meeting or discuss other concerns, please email the school at info@mops.nsw.edu.au. List the topics you wish to discuss in point form. Your email will be directed to the relevant staff member and someone will be in contact with you. Please understand that schools are busy places, and staff members may not always be able to communicate with you straight away, but will make every effort to get back to you as soon as possible.
- If you happen to have a teacher's personal phone number, please do not share it with others. It would also be greatly appreciated if you please respect their privacy and keep calls within reasonable hours on school days.
- When calling or visiting the School Office, please note that their hours are 8:30am 3:30pm.
- If for an unforeseen circumstance you are running late for pickup at 3pm, please call to let the office staff know. Your child/ren will wait for you at the office, but you will need to arrange for alternative pickup if you cannot arrive by 3:30pm. Our caring office staff are sometimes staying outside of their paid hours to ensure each child is safely picked up.


